**PARENT AMBASSADOR PROGRAM** - JAGC works in positive partnership with the Jeffco School District's Gifted & Talented (GT) Department to provide leadership by promoting information about the educational and social-emotional needs of gifted and talented students. The JAGC Ambassador Program extends this leadership from the district level into individual school buildings. JAGC Ambassadors are parent volunteers who receive training in how to serve GT students, parents, and staff in school buildings and within articulation areas.

**EVENTS** - Help us with publicity and preparations for seminars and other activities.
