Happy spring break and welcome back soon to in-person learning for our hybrid students!


JAGC is holding our annual election in April. For voting members, you will receive a ballot by email. Please vote and return your ballot by April 10.

<u>Jeffco Remote Learning Program for 2021-22 School Year - Enroll by</u>

April 7

Jeffco is offering a full-time in-person learning for all grades, as well as a centrally run PK-12 remote learning option with synchronous instruction. After April 7, schools will send all applicants to the remote learning program waitlist and send offers as they have space. This allows schools and the remote program to determine interest, enrollment numbers, and begin staffing and scheduling. On Aug. 31 when Round 2 Choice Enrollment ends, schools will manage students who want to switch environments through the admin transfer process.

<u>Summer Credit Advancement for Grades 11-12 - Application Opens April 30</u>

Jeffco Virtual Academy offers two 4-week sessions during the summer for students to take a class they haven't attempted before to get ahead in credits. Courses are online. Students can complete a semester course in just four weeks. The cost is \$165-200 per class. Courses offered:

JCEA Scholarships - Apply by April 18

The Jefferson County Education Association (JCEA) awards several scholarships to seniors who attend Jeffco Public Schools.

--The JCEA Excellence Fund Scholarship

Awarded to a Jefferson County high school senior entering college the following year to pursue a degree in education. Each scholarship is for \$1,000 per year and can be renewed for up to four years (\$4,000 total).



--Sue Anne Berger Physical Science Scholarship

Awarded to two graduating seniors from the Jeffco Public Schools who intend to study the physical sciences or related fields. Each scholarship starts with \$1000 and is increased by \$1,000 each year, up to four years (\$10,000 total).

-- The JCEA Shermita West Student of Color Scholarship

Annual award given to a Jeffco high school student of color who is pursuing a career in education. Each scholarship is for \$1,000 per year and may be renewed for up to four years (\$4,000 total)..

The Davidson Young Scholars program provides free services designed to nurture and support profoundly gifted young people and their families, including talent development, educational advocacy, an online community and the Ambassadors program.
