



The Colorado Student Leaders Institute (COSLI) is a state-legislated, summer residential program. From July 2 to July 29, students live and study on the University of Colorado Denver campus and earn three hours of college credit. Students choose one of two majors through which to explore an interdisciplinary curriculum: International Social Studies or STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Math), and explore diverse topics through a lecture series by university professors and

three hands-on projects--Colorado Social Problem Lab, Short-Term Business Lab, and National History Day. COSLI students do not have to be formally designated as gifted and talented students, but they must
