GT Family Resources for Summer

Advanced Learning Plans (ALPs) Goal Closeout



As the year is coming to an end, teachers and students will review the progress the students have made toward meeting their Advanced Learning Plan (ALP).

From March through the beginning of May, and depending on the age of the students, teachers and students use data from classroom assessments, project rubrics and individualized anecdotal data to determine whether the student has met his or her goal. Even though a student's goal will be closed for the year, their ALP remains with them and they will set a new goal at the beginning of the next school year.
